

Erdemir Group, which closed the past year with a high performance and is one of the private institutions that create the highest employment in Turkey, was included in the 2014 “Top 500 Large Industrial Companies of Turkey” report of Istanbul Chamber of Commerce (ISO) with four companies, two of which made it to the top 10.

The rankings of 2014 were based on the companies’ sales of their own products, and Erdemir Group companies, İskenderun Demir ve Çelik A.Ş. and Ereğli Demir ve Çelik Fabrikaları T.A.Ş. ranked 7th and 8th with sales figures of 6.2 billion TL and 6.1 billion TL, respectively.

In the previous year’s report, Ereğli Demir ve Çelik Fabrikaları T.A.Ş. had the 8th place with a sales figure of 5.3 billion TL and İskenderun Demir ve Çelik A.Ş. the 9th place with 5.2 billion TL.

Providing its services from four different intensely industrial regions including Gebze, Ereğli, İskenderun and Manisa, Erdemir Çelik Servis Merkezi San. ve Tic. A.Ş. moved up 107 ranks compared to last year in the 2014 “Top 500 Large Industrial Companies of Turkey” report, reaching the 137th place with a sales figure of 661 million TL. The company had ranked 244th in last year’s report.

Erdemir Madencilik San. ve Tic. A.Ş., another Group company which has mine sites in Sivas and Malatya, ranked 221st with a sales figure of 441 million TL in the same report. Ermaden had ranked 216th in the 2013 report.

With these results, Erdemir Group achieved a sales figure of more than 13.4 billion TL with its companies which were included in the 2014 “Top 500 Large Industrial Companies of Turkey” report. Erdemir Group Chairman Ali Pandır made the following comment on the subject during the opening of the new Headquarters in Ataşehir, Istanbul: “We have big dreams for the future, for our country and our group. We are in top 10 of ISO’s top 500 rankings with two Group companies, İsdemir and Erdemir. We are one of the few Turkish companies which made it into Forbes Global 2000. Our aim for the next 5 years is to become a world-class company which creates maximum value for all of its stakeholders, is respected, sets an example, people want to work at, produces what is not produced and develops solutions for not only today’s but also tomorrow’s needs.”
